Take tests individually option (recommended):

- Reading individually \$90 4 hours test time

• Reading/Writing (4 hours for both) \$130 (not recommended due to test exhaustion) Registration:

- Create an account, pay for the test, register for the test.
- If you don't pass, retake reading or writing, 30 day waiting period to retest
