

Entry Assessments

- ☐ VCLA Reading & Writing (Your reading and writing score, combined 470)

<https://www.va.nesinc.com/> Highly suggested to take in person and not online, there are limited testing dates. Please connect with Success Coaches/Tutors to help prepare.

Take tests individually option (recommended):

- Reading – individually \$90 4 hours test time
- Writing – individually \$90 4 hour test time

Take tests together option:

- Reading/Writing (4 hours for both) \$130 (not recommended due to test exhaustion)

Registration:

- Create an account, pay for the test, register for the test.
- If you don't pass, retake reading **or** writing, 30 day waiting period to retest
- Email official scores to teacher-ed@jmu.edu

- ☐ Math Entry Assessment: One of the following: ALEKS, PRAXIS, Math ACT OR Math SAT

- ALEKS score 46; Free – 3 attempts - <https://www.jmu.edu/coe/esc/files/aleks-testing.pdf> **or**
- Praxis 5733 - (score of 150) (\$90) <https://www.ets.org/praxis/site/test-takers/register.html> **or**
- May be exempt ACT Math score of 22 **or**
- SAT Math score of 560 (on or after 3/1/16) or SAT Math score of 530 (between 4/1/95 – 2/29/16)

Grades and GPA

- ☐ GPA of at least 2.5 or higher
- ☐ WRTC 103, PSYC 160, and EDUC 200 (or equivalents), earn a C or above
