Program Information**

- This outline is only a planning tool – please consult the catalog for official graduation requirements.
- To declare the major, the student must submit a request in MyMadison as well as view a major orientation video and complete a quiz online. Incoming first-year and transfer students who have not previously matriculated to JMU will declare the major as part of orientation, and do not need to complete these additional steps.
- All required HM classes are offered Fall and Spring – there is limited summer availability for some classes, but this should not be depended upon to speed up graduation date.
- The Hospitality Management program requires two internships (HM 333 and HM 444). These internships may be fulfilled at any eligible location, with associated coursework being completed on campus for local interns, and virtually for interns who have travelled away from Harrisonburg. Internships may also be completed during the summer.
- The HM Elective requirement (9 credits) may be fulfilled by any HM courses that are not specifically required for the major.
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- Some students may apply for and be accepted into the Entrepreneurship minor. This minor replaces the General Business requirements for SRM students. All SRM students must complete either the General Business or the Entrepreneurship minor.
- All courses, including internships, carry tuition costs. Summer tuition is billed separately.
- A final 2.0 GPA is required for all declared programs, including the required minor.
- All students must earn a minimum of 120 credits for graduation.
- It is the student's responsibility to:
  - be aware of and abide by departmental policies and deadlines.
  - be aware of all prerequisites as outlined in the catalog.
  - be aware of and fulfill all graduation requirements as outlined in the catalog.
  - declare the appropriate major (HM – BS) and minor (General Business) via MyMadison.
