
Welcome to the Hart School

- What advice do you wish you had received as an undergrad? Your education is yours. Don't allow fear to determine your outcome.




Academic Advisor Jason Gochenour, M.Ed.

- What is your favorite place on campus? Rose Library, the smashing views.




SRM - Lecturer Alyssa Bosley, M.S.


SRM - Professor and SRL Assistant Director Dr. Julia Wallace Carr


SRM - Lecturer Dr. Guy deBrun

- What advice do you wish you had received as an undergrad? It is ok to make mistakes as long as we learn from them.




SRM - Lecturer Angela Hayslett, J.D., M.S.

 because you can apply that knowledge to your learning.




HM - Assistant Professor Dr. Yuan (Pam) Li
